

Poster Guidelines for the 7 Miracles of Jesus

You are invited to participate in making a poster that illustrates one of the Seven Miracles of Jesus in the Gospel of John. We will be studying these Seven Miracles during the season of Lent with a special presentation at the Children's Time, on Wednesday night at the Cornerstone Café, and also in the Children's Sunday School program. The kick-off date is March 9, the first Sunday in Lent.

This is designed to be a family event with discussion on the Miracle, fun with illustrating the miracle, and use of any art mediums including crayons, markers, colored pencils, watercolors, and/or collages with colorful paper and images. It is truly your own design as inspired by your study and discussions.

There will be some resources to help you with the discussion and craft projects for each of the seven miracles. These resources will be available either online at our website or individual packets made available on the Welcome Table at both worship services.

You can create as many posters as you would like. You are asked to bring the poster(s) to church the following week and they will be displayed in both the Cornerstone and the Sanctuary. It will be exciting to see the beautiful display of posters over the seven-week Lenten series.

Considerations for your Poster

- Letter (8.5 x 11 inches) or Legal (8.5 x 14 inches) are optimal sizes. You can also use a larger size but it should not exceed 12 x 18 inches due to space limitations.**
- Include the Miracle as the title at the top and the names of the artists designing the poster at the bottom.**
- Use bright colors and visual images or pictures.**
- Use easy to read type, and the minimum font size recommended is 36 point type.**
- Have fun and be creative.**
