Title: What is God's Purpose for My Life at This Time?

Hello Church Family,

Becoming a disciple of Jesus Christ is the greatest adventure we will ever choose. Through our faith, Jesus will lead us to understand ourselves more deeply and honestly than we ever thought possible. He will lead us out in service of others to places and peoples we would never have chosen or imagined. Saying, "Yes" to Jesus is to say, "Yes" to life. Choosing to live for Jesus is to choose to live life on purpose. It is the decision to not simply drift, repeating the hurts and sin of the past. Saying, "Yes" to Jesus, is the decision to embrace the one special life that God has instore for us and to live it to its fullest.

I encourage you this summer to wrestle with the question, "What is God's purpose for my life at this time?"

Sometimes were fear embracing the purpose we hear God inviting us to step into. We fear the hurts of the past will return. We also can stay focused on past success and don't open ourselves to imagine new goals and purposes God has instore for us.

As you discern God's purpose for your life, consider how the apostle Paul writes to the church in Philippi about how God guided him to let go of his sinful past as a persecutor of the church and his accomplishments as a follower of the law of Moses when he writes.

"If anyone else has reason to be confident in the flesh, I have more: <sup>5</sup> circumcised on the eighth day, a member of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew born of Hebrews; as to the law, a Pharisee; <sup>6</sup> as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to righteousness under the law, blameless.

<sup>7</sup>Yet whatever gains I had, these I have come to regard as loss because of Christ. <sup>8</sup>More than that, I regard everything as loss because of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things, and I regard them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ." Philippians 3:4-8

Paul embraced faith in Christ as his future. He embraced faith in Christ as the greatest thing he could devote himself to. He discerned that God was calling him to invite new people to share in Jesus's grace through founding new churches. This purpose was very different than where Paul had previously discerned God was calling him to invest his life. We owe Paul a debt of gratitude for his witness. We give thanks that he opened himself to hearing God's purpose for his life.

I would to invite you to join us on Sundays during our learning time at 10 am in June and July in our Cornerstone Building to discuss the scriptures in small groups and discern together, "What is God's purpose for your life at this time?" You will find supportive people that can help you to discern God's purpose.


