Below is an introduction to Emotionally Healthy Spirituality materials by Peter Scazzero.

Emotionally unhealthy spirituality wreaks havoc in our personal lives and our churches. When, for example, we deny the past's impact on the present, judge other people's spiritual journeys, or spiritualize away conflict, we hurt both ourselves and those around us. An emotionally unhealthy spirituality also hinders us from breaking deeply rooted, unhealthy relationship patterns and maturing in Christ.

The problem is twofold: First, we neglect to pay attention to what is going on inside us. And second, we are too busy to stop, slow down, and be with God. As a result, we run the high risk of remaining stuck as spiritual infants, failing to grow into spiritual/ emotional adults in Christ.

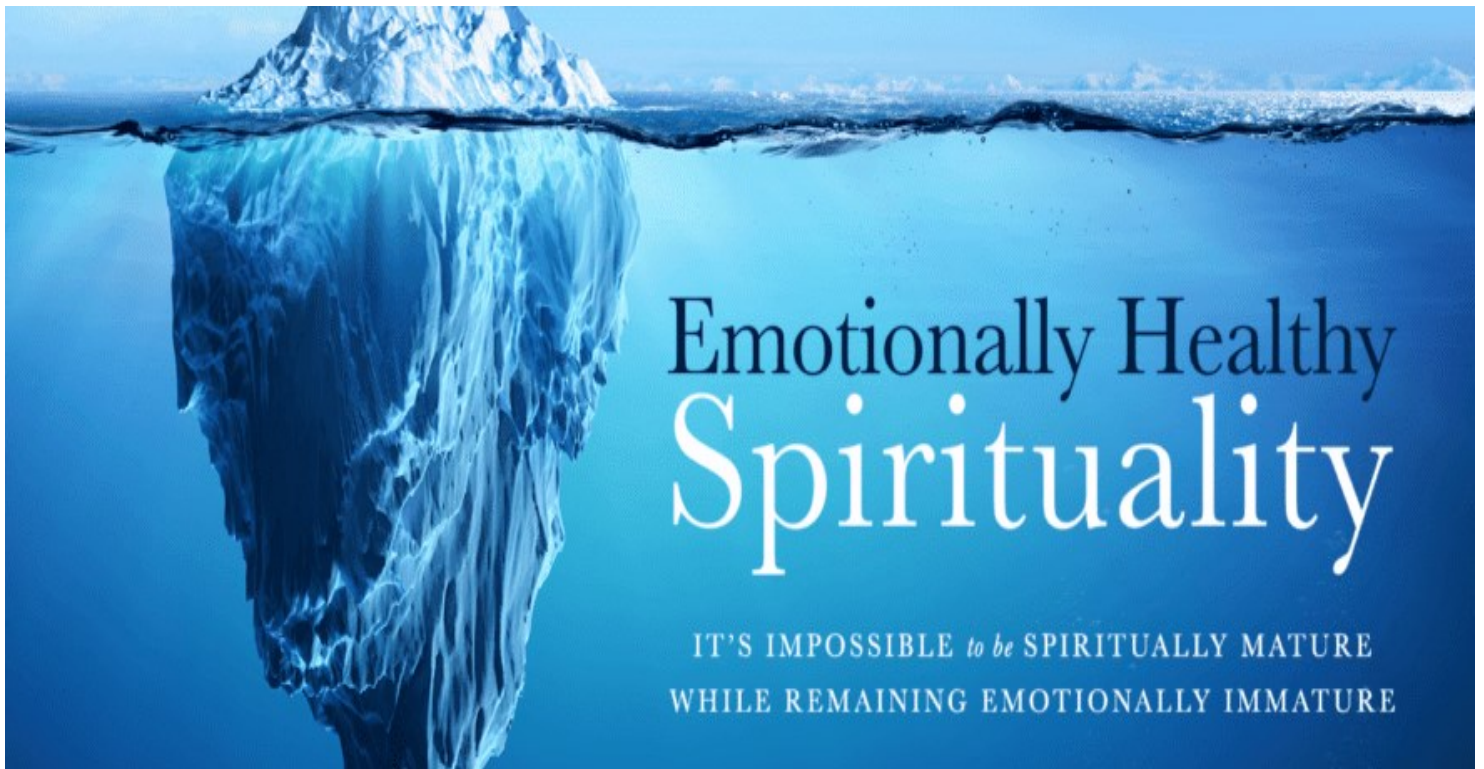

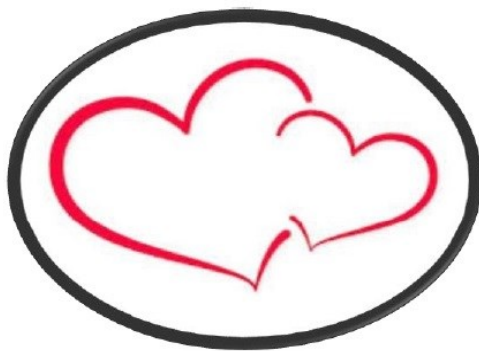

# Monthly Church News


Theresa and Denny Lumos became members of our church on October 26th. We are so blessed and look forward to growing in God's love together.

**Bio:** Denny grew up in Leadwood, where his family owned a furniture and hardware store. He majored in Vocal Music at Southeast Missouri State University and then earned a Master of Divinity at seminary. He served as an associate pastor in Gladstone and Festus, and as senior pastor for congregations in Lewistown and Poplar Bluff, before having the great privilege of serving as Campus Minister at the Wesley House at Southeast Missouri State University. He took a family leave of absence nine years later (19 years ago) when he lost his son Caleb who was a student at SEMO. He has worked several jobs in sales and chauffeuring since that time and retired in May. Through the years, he developed his skill in pottery, taking it from a hobby to a true art form. He plans to pursue that craft in his retirement years. He is also a musician and hopes to work with the church and community to form a Drum Circle. Drum Circles offer great satisfaction and therapeutic benefits. He hopes to be able to form an adult circle as well as a teen circle. He invites everyone to come and try it out!

Theresa grew up in Bonne Terre, the daughter of a 4<sup>th</sup> generation Baptist Minister. She has an undergraduate degree in Elementary Education and taught for five years before getting her Masters in Counseling. She has worked for the past 22 years as a children's therapist, mainly working with the children and families of our military. This allowed her and Denny to travel to military installations throughout the United States, as well as in Germany, England, and Japan. During COVID when traveling was restricted, she returned to teaching, working as a middle school teacher on a Navajo Reservation in New Mexico. After COVID, she returned to working with military families, most recently at Scott Air Force Base in Illinois. She retired in May and hopes to work part-time doing children's therapy for the next few years.

Denny and Theresa have been married for almost 49 years. They survived the worst thing that can happen to parents when they lost their precious son. They were changed forever by that heartbreaking experience but know they will see him again someday. They have two surviving adult children, James and Bethany. They also have two adult grandsons. Eli lives and works in St. Louis, and Blake serves in the Army, presently stationed in Georgia.

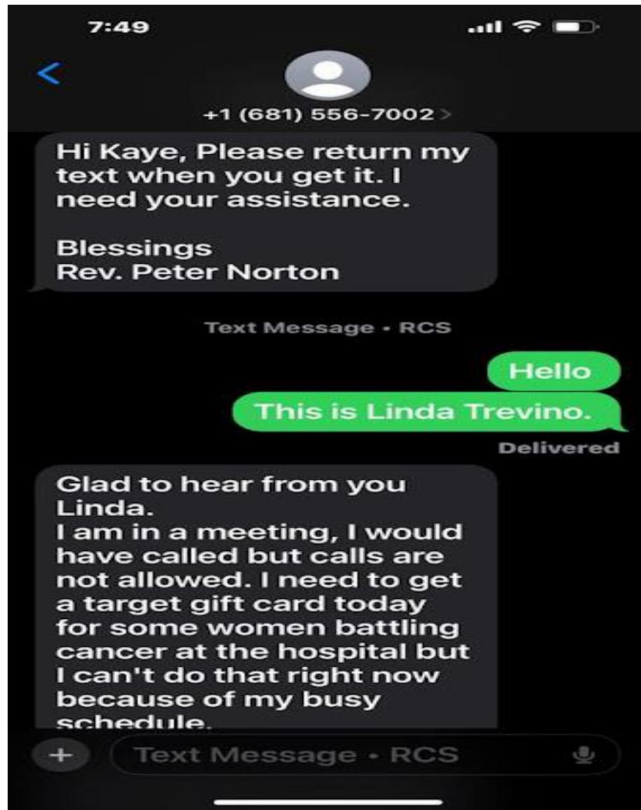

# Subject: Avoid Church Scammers

Hello church family,

The Missouri Annual Conference recently put out a message encouraging local churches and congregants to be aware of possible financial scams. It is easy for scammers to send emails or text messages that look like they are coming from church staff and members. Several church members received a text message asking for gift cards like the one below.

To avoid scammers, know that the church staff and congregants will never ask you to buy things like gift cards or make direct cash transfers into a personal account. Also know that we work hard all year to plan in advance and chart a clear and smooth financial course for our church. There should never be a sense of urgency in giving. Additionally, while I have many commitments, I am careful not to become overcommitted and unable to receive and respond to messages in a timely manner.
